## Editor's mid-year 2014 Summary for Waterbirds

31 July 2014

My role as editor is now in its second year, with Sandy MacPherson continuing as the associate editor and E. O. Painter Printing Company continuing as the publisher. We have continued to receive submissions from a broad international base (30 countries this period). During this period, the mean days to decision = 55, to publication = 193. Data on submission origin, acceptance rate, and page counts for this period are provided in the tables at the end.

**Volume 37 Summary:** *Waterbirds* issues 37(1) (March 2014) and 37(2) (June 2014) were both published on schedule and contained a combination of 15 Articles and 10 Notes in 232 pages. Issue 37(3) (September 2014) is at the printer and contains nine Articles and three Notes. Volume 37(4) is on track for December 2014 and is slated to contain 10 Articles and five Notes. Mid-year and annual submission rates are summarized below. Note that we appear to be rebounding in submission rate from a mid-year low of 52 in 2013.
