#### 2012-2013 Committee Activities

### <u>Student Travel Awards</u>

We solicited applications for student travel awards for the upcoming 2013 meeting in Wilhelmshaven Germany and received 28 applications. The breakdown of where students are from is as follows: 60% were from North America, 37% from Europe and 3.7% were from Russia/Egypt (Table 1).

An attempt was made to provide higher levels of funding for non-North American students (as per the motion to increase funds was to provide more support for students of local geography). Of the 28 awards offered, two are declined, three are undecided (as of Jul 30) and the rest have accepted the award. Assuming that the three undecided students accept their offers, the total funds allocated to student travel awards are \$3270. The amount Executive allocated was \$3400.

#### Student presentations

Six members (Dave Moore, Stephanie Jones, Dave Shealer, Jennifer Arnold (posters only), Brian Palestis and Gail Fraser) have volunteered to evaluate student presentations. Assuming we have 26 students presenting with two people assigned per student, each member would evaluate 8 talks or posters. So it would be good if there were two more volunteers to reduce that number.
